DETAILS OF ESTABLISHMENT, FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES

2.1	As per Section 61 (H) of Mumbai Municipal Corporation Act 1888, it is an obligatory duty of MCGM to construct and maintain the Slaughter House.
2.2	Deonar Abattoir is run by Municipal Corporation which does not aim at the profit but gives priority to the Public health. Public in general, shopkeepers, merchants etc. are getting benefits of its services.
2.3	Deonar Abattoir is a semi-mechanised abattoir of Municipal Corporation. It was built by M/s.W.J.Powel with co-operation of M/s.Steel Plant Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai, in accordance with the lay out suggested by Shri. N. E. Wenburg, Advisor to World Agricultural Organisation. Its construction work started in the year 1967 and ended in 1971. The total cost of construction of the abattoir along with the machineries was Rs.4.5 crores. The work commenced on 18 th August, 1971. Other slaughter houses at Bandra, Kurla were closed and full fledged functioning started in April, 1972. Deonar Abattoir complex is spread over in 64 acres.
2.4	It is the duty of the Abattoir to make the place available for market of sheep, goats, horned animals brought for slaughtering, to examine the animals before and after the slaughter, to provide clean and hygienic meat.
2.5	<p>Prime Functions :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Issue licenses decide the timings for slaughtering, to keep control according to the other rules of Abattoir and Municipal Bye-Laws 461 (k, l, m, n), 462. 2. To maintain the Deonar Abattoir and the market with full responsibility. 3. Slaughter the animals by charging the stipulated slaughtering charges. 4. Dispose off the by-products scientifically. 5. The Vigilance Squad of the Market Department seize the Horned animals, sheep, goats, pigs which are brought for unauthorized slaughter. They also seize the unauthorized meat. Seized Sheep and goats are given to the contractors appointed by market department. Pigs, buffaloes, male buffalo calf are given to the license holders by auction for slaughtering at Deonar Abattoir and the animals unfit for slaughtering are given in possession of "Jivadaya Mandali" by accepting prescribed charges. Since the seized meat is unfit for human consumption, it is destroyed with scientific methods. 6. To keep control over the special market for Bakri-Eid and to regulate slaughtering. 7. Give religious pass for transporting only sheep and goats for religious purposes.
2.6	<p>Following facilities have been provided in the Abattoir.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Platform for unloading animals. 2. Separate market for sheep, goats and horned animals. 3. Specious shelter houses for animals. 4. Separate slaughter houses for sheep, goats, horned animals, pigs. 5. Pump house for providing fresh water. 6. Drainage System and ETP plant 7. Dispensary for Municipal Employees. 8. Meat Van Garage. 9. Vegetarian and Non-Vegetarian restaurants for workers, merchants, shopkeepers etc. 10. Shelter sheds for merchants, commission agents, gawal, workers etc. 11. Office premises. 12. Quality Control Laboratory. 13. Environment friendly Bio-Methanation Plant. <p>There is a police station in the complex of this Abattoir.</p>

2.7	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. An appeal is made to the public to purchase meat from the Municipal Licensed shops.2. While approaching for obtaining license for religious purpose, a ration card as well as certificate of local police station having their no objection for the slaughter is necessary.
2.8	Special facilities are provided to the public during "Bakri-Eid
2.9	Competent officers have been appointed to redress the problems faced by public.
