Development Control Regulation No. 67 was approved by the state Govt. vide DCR/1090/3197/RDP/UD11 dated 21st April 1995. Now, this regulation has been changed to Reg.no.52 in DCPR-2034. The Committee advises Municipal Commissioner on various matters related to heritage conservation as elucidated in regulation 52 of DCPR-2034.
