<u>CHAPTER - 9 (MANUAL - 8)</u>

THE PROCEDURE FOLLOWED IN THE DECISION MAKING PROCESS

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9.1 Procedure followed in the decision making process:-

Municipal Printing Press is official printer for Municipal Corporation. The all activities, like pre-press operation, production analysis, stock level, delivery etc. is handled by PPC Section. (Production Planning and controll cell). As per Rules and regulations of M.C.G. M. & Sanction of Competent Authority.

Procedure followed in the decision making process for "Store Purchase". Municipal Printing Press follow the procedure for purchase as guided by C.A.(F) department.

- **9.2** What are documents / procedures laid down procedures / Defined Criteria Rules to arive at a particular decision for important matters? What are different levels through which a decision process moves?
- **9.3** What are the arrangement to communicate the decision to the public?
 - News Paper, Website, MCGM Portal, Notice Board.
- 9.4 Who are the officers at various levels whose opinions are sought for the processs of decision making?

Concerned Incharge of chief personal officer, Division, Chief Acc. Office, Labour Office, Law Officer, Central Excise consultant.

- **9.5** Who is the final authority that wets the decision?
 - Municipal Commissioner.
- **9.6** Provide information for the important matters on which the decisions is taken by Public Authority. Not Applicable.

PPC- receive indents from consuming departments for schedule/non-schedule work and takes-care up to delivery of the goods.

Municipal Printing Press purchases raw-material/allied materials required for printing, binding, pre-press operation etc.

- 9.3 Communication is through letters sent by post/courier & to make use of websites & newspapers.
- **9.4** The orders of the Competent Authority are obtained.
- 9.5 All the powers of granting approval are vested in Addl. Municipal Commissioner. However for smooth & quick disposal of the proposals some of the powers are delegated to D. M. C. (E) & Manager.

9.6 As there is no direct relation between Public & M. P. P. No decisions are taken by the Public Authority.
