FIRE & LIFE SAFETY AUDITOR

- The purpose of introducing Fire & Life Safety Auditor is to check the various fire & life safety measures to be provided in the low-rise residential building (active & passive) as per the provisions of Maharashtra Fire Prevention & Life Safety Measures Act – 2006, DCPR-2034, NBC-2016 & Building Byelaws.
- ii. At the time of construction of the building Fire & Life Safety Auditor along with Fire Safety Consultant and Architect will ensure the provisions of various Fire & Life Safety Measures (active & passive) which are codified by the Fire Department.
- iii. Duties of Fire & Life Safety Auditor To carry out work related to development permission with respect to Fire Safety measures in low rise residential buildings and to submit –
 - a) To issue Fire Safety Compliance Certificate in prescribed format along with schematic drawing showing various fire safety measures provided as per Codified Fire Safety requirements.
 - b) To carry out the testing of all active measures related to the fire & life safety provided in the building.
 - c) To upload photographs / videos of inspection & testing of Fire Fighting installations / equipment provided as per Codified Fire Safety Requirements with date & time stamp along with Compliance Certificate through concerned Architect.
 - d) Documents to be submitted along with Compliance Certificate
 - i. Certified Copy of **Codified Fire Safety requirements** applicable for the building.
 - ii. Copies of **Fire Lift Certificate** from PWD (for building height more than 24 mtrs).
 - iii. Test Certificate regarding Electric Audit for electrical fittings/fixtures installed in the building as per Electricity Act & Rules from Electrical Inspector / Govt. approved Electrical Contractor.
 - iv. As per Sec-3(3); Rule 4(2) of Maharashtra Fire Prevention & Life Safety Measures Act-2006, Form-A Certificate from authorized Licensed agency regarding Fire-Fighting & Fire-Protection system / equipment / FRD, stipulated / installed in the building.

iv. <u>Qualification and Eligibility of Fire & Life Safety Auditor (Any one of</u> <u>the following i.e. a, b or c)</u>

a. At least any of the following qualifications, namely:-

i) A degree or Advanced Diploma or Diploma in Fire Engineering awarded by the National Fire Service College, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India.

OR

- ii) Fellow of Fire Engineering of the institution of Fire Engineer (UK) or M.I. Fire (U.K.) or A.M.I.E. Fire India, Graduateship Examination of the institution of Fire Engineering (U.K. / India) or the Institution Fire Engineer (India)
- **b.** i) A degree or diploma in Mechanical or Electrical or Electronics or Chemical or Civil Engineering or Computer Applications from a recognised university

AND

ii) Experience in execution and supervision of the work relating to fire protection and life safety measures in a building or a project as an officer or supervisory officer as laid down in the DCR-1991, DCPR-2034, Maharashtra Fire Prevention & Life Safety Measures Act- 2006, National Building Code-2005 or the code published by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA, USA) 2008, as amended from time to time, <u>**OR**</u>

in case of (b) above, has in his employment, for the purpose of execution and supervision of the work relating to fire protection and life safety measures in a building or a project, an officer or supervisory officer holding any of the qualifications mentioned in clause (a), so however that, a degree or diploma in fire engineering or any other qualifications in relation to fire protection, prevention and safety measures specified therein shall be an essential qualification.

c. Retired Fire Officer (above the rank of Sub-Officer) who has 15 years experience in Regular Fire Service of Municipal Corporation or Special Planning Authority or Public Sector Undertaking.

v. Empanelment of Fire & Life Safety Auditor -

a. The Fire & Life Safety Auditor should have the empaneled with Chief Fire Officer, Mumbai Fire Brigade, Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai to Act as Fire & Life Safety Auditor and the application in the format shall be submitted.

- b. The empanelment fees of Rs. 5,000/- shall be paid to MCGM for the empanelment to act as a Fire & Life Safety Auditor.
- c. The Fire & Life Safety Auditor should get empaneled annually by paying the renewal fees of Rs. 2500/-.
- d. The selection for empanelment of Fire & Life Safety Auditor will be done with the approval of AMC (E.S.)
- e. If The Compliance Certificate issued without fulfillment of requirement as mentioned in the Fire & Life Safety requirements as stipulated by the Fire Brigade, then the License issued to act as Fire & Life Safety Auditor will be suspended by the Chief Fire Officer and the action such as Blacklisting will be initiated.
