PRICING DOCUMENT and PAYMENT SCHEDULE



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1.1 Preamble

The Pricing Document shall be read in conjunction with Notice of Intimation to RFP, Instructions to Tenderers and all Tender Documents, Specifications and Drawings as listed in the Contents of the Tender Documents, Page 3 of Notice of Intimation to RFP Volume 1.

The Contract is a lump sum priced Contract, adjusted by the Price Adjustment Formula detailed in Sub-Clause 81 of Particular Conditions of Contract (PCC) Volume 2. The Works are sub-divided into Payment Centre representing one or more groups of inter-related works forming part of the Works. A brief Scope of Works is given in Section B2 of the Employer's Requirements Volume 3 - Functional.

The individual item descriptions within each Payment Centre are indicative only of the Work included in this Contract and shall not be taken as defining the scope of work to be executed either under the Payment Centre or the Contract.

The item descriptions, if given, are general summaries only, therefore no omission from, or error in, item descriptions within this Pricing Document shall warrant an adjustment of the Contract Price nor entitle the Contractor to seek an extension of time under the Contract.

The breakdown of Lump sum rates and item descriptions, with the breakdown cost of each lump sum item as submitted by the Contractor in accordance with the Clause 1.3.3.3 of this Volume and shall be used as the basis for evaluating any Variations pursuant to Clause 13 [Variations and Adjustment] of the General Conditions of Contract (GCC) and Particular Conditions of Contract (PCC). For pricing variation, the BMC's Unified Schedule of Rates for Common Building and Construction Works shall be followed, and in the event that items are not covered in the BMC's SoR, then the latest edition of the respective Current SoR of the concerned Department shall be used.

The individual percentages inserted in the Percentage Column of the Payment Centre shall be used for the sole purpose of assessing amounts due for inclusion or exclusion within the interim payments.

The percentage rate for each item detailed in Payment Centres A, B, C, D, E, F, G & H of this Pricing Document are for finished items of work 100% complete in all respects, and shall be held to include all waste on materials, duties, landing charges, shipping costs for transport by air, sea or land (or any combination thereof), insurance, all taxes and duties, unloading, storage, getting into position, hoisting, lowering, erection, distributing to positions, fixing, temporary works including false-work and formwork (shuttering), demolition, excavation, removal of debris, labour, materials, scaffolding and staging, plant, supervision, maintenance, Contractor's profit and establishment/ overheads, together with preparation of design and drawings, all general risks, insurance liabilities, compliance of labour laws and taxes/duties, etc. as per statuary obligations set out or implied in the Contract, making good prior to handing over to the Employer and anything reasonably to be inferred from the description of the item and indispensably necessary thereto, and all other requirements of the Contract.

The activity descriptions for items within Payment Centres shall be deemed to cover all aspects of the relevant item scope, irrespective of the fact that the Bidder may not have taken into account in his Lumpsum quote against any item description. The total amount of each Payment Centre shall be deemed inclusive of all of the Contractor's obligations to execute that part of the Works covered by the Payment Centre and to perform all of his other obligations under the Contract in respect thereof. The Contractor shall not be entitled to receive any further or additional payment in respect of such Payment Centre.

The total amount of each of the Payment Centres A to H shall be equal to 100% of the Sum of the Payment inserted into the Pricing quote in Clause 1.7.1.

1.2 Contract Price

The Lump sum price quoted inclusive of GST and all taxes, levies, duties, Royalties etc. in the Clause 1.7.1, constitutes the Contract Price which shall be the total amount to be paid to the Contractor for executing the Works and performing all other obligations under the Contract.

The Contract Price shall not be subject to adjustment by the Contractor in respect of any error or oversight in the preparation of the Pricing Document, and they represent the full extent of the Contractor's entitlement to receive payment in respect of this work.

The payment towards contract sum shall be only in INR.

1.3 Description of Payment Centres

The Pricing Documents comprise Payment Centre "A", which represents Preliminaries, General and Design Requirements associated with Payment Centres B to H inclusive, and Payment Centres "B, C, D, E, F, G & H" which represent a series of work activities comprising a complete component when constructed.

1.3.1. Payment Centre A

Payment Centre A is dedicated to Preliminaries, General & Design Requirements as stated in the Centre of Payments, including, but not limited to, the following, as per the requirements and other details given in the Employer's Requirements, Drawings and Specifications;

- a) Initial Works Programme
- b) Three Month Rolling Programme
- c) Detailed Works Programme
- d) Monthly Progress Report
- e) Software Support Plan
- f) Back-up copies of the Software Submission
- g) Interface Management Plan
- h) Co-ordination Installation Plan for all works
- i) Project Management Information System
- j) Contractor's Staff Organisation Plan

- k) Occupational Safety, Health & Environmental Plan
- I) OHS&E Manual requirements submission
- m) Environmental Management Plan
- n) Dust Control Plan
- o) Temporary Traffic and Control Plan
- p) Accommodation proposals and provisions
- q) Procurement Plan
- r) Contractor's Manufacturing Management Plan
- s) Testing and Commissioning Programme
- t) Test Procedures
- u) Inspection and Test Plan
- v) Factory Test Plan
- w) Partial Acceptance Test Plan
- x) System Acceptance Test Plan
- y) Maintenance Support Plan
- z) All interfacing works within the Project and other Interfacing Contractors, and
- aa) All other items included in the Scope of Works given in Employer's Requirements (Volume 3).
- bb) The geotechnical information given in Volume 7 are for reference only. The contractor shall carryout adequate number of bore holes and testing to ascertain the geotechnical conditions to perform the design accordingly for which payment will be made as per Item A2.11. The number of bore holes given there are only indicative.
- cc) Design of the temporary and permanent works

The Bidder is to note that some of the Items are payable as a portion of the indicated percentage on a monthly or quarterly basis or are paid proportionately using the percentages of the items of works.

The Bidder should note that if any of the Key Staff is not employed and/or not reported for the work on site within 30 days of date of mobilisation as per the Noticed Contractor's Programme, there shall be a deduction of INR 10.00 lakhs for each month or part thereof for each missing Key Staff, as determined by the Employer / the Engineer and whose decision shall be final and binding.

A Key Staff shall be replaced only in exceptional and unavoidable circumstances and subject to the following:

- Only when a replacement Key Staff with equivalent or better qualification and experience is Noticed by the Engineer and duly employed by the Contractor and in-place; and
- 2. A penalty of INR 10.00 lakhs will be recovered from the Contractor's Interim Payments.

1.3.2. Payment Centres "B, C, D, E F,G & H"

Payment Centres "B,C,D,E,F,G & H" are dedicated to construction and finishing of all works including at-grade road and allied works, box culverts, solid ramp with RE wall, enabling works, road on stilt, obligatory span with 80/100m, Interchanges, electrification and street lighting, restoration/ reinstatement of the road works, architectural and builders works, building services, finishes and electrical services etc. as specified and as stated in the Centre of Payments, as per the requirements and other details given in the Employer's Requirements, Drawings and Specifications, and as briefly listed in Clause B2 (1) of Volume 3.

The Contractor is to note that some of the Items are payable proportionately using the percentages of the items of works, as cumulative percentages.

The Contractor's Lumpsum Price shall include diversion of utilities identified in the tender documents (chartered utilities). Works relating to diversion, relocation, etc. of the uncharted utilities necessitated by the Works the payment shall be on a BOQ measurement basis and the rates shall be based on the BMC's Unified Schedule of Rates for Common Building and Construction Works, and in the event the rates are not available in BMC's SoR then the latest edition of the CPWD Schedule of Rates, applicable to Mumbai or Schedule of Rates of the concerned Utilities Department shall be used.

The Bidder shall carry out the works relating to utilities in consultation with the concerned utility agencies. Also at the time of execution of this work, if required/insisted by the utility agencies, their approved Sub-contractors shall be used.

The cost of works/activities pertaining to those utilities which are required to be retained/protected (or those utilities that are not permitted to be diverted by the Relevant Authorities) during construction will be deemed to be included in the Lump sum Price quoted.

1.3.3. Price / Cost Breakdown

- 1.3.3.1. The Lump sum price apportioned shall be deemed to include for all costs associated with the supply, and delivery to Site of such item by the Contractor (including, without limitation, the cost of design, manufacture, packing, supply and delivery to Site, testing and commissioning, labour cost as applicable, preliminaries and other general requirements, overheads and profit, etc.) irrespective of the quantity of the items to be supplied.
- 1.3.3.2. The percentage indicated for each item detailed in Payment Centres, A to H of this Pricing Document is for payment only for finished items of work, 100% complete in all respects, as stated in Clause 1.1 of this, Pricing Document.
- 1.3.3.3. Within 56 days from the date of receipt of LOA, the Contractor shall submit a detailed breakup of Lumpsum, apportioned against each Payment Centre.
- 1.3.3.4. Variations will only be considered if there is any additional work required beyond the scope of works or the Employer/ the Engineer instructs any changes to the existing scope.
- 1.3.3.5. Payments to the Contractor will be made on a monthly basis in accordance with Clause 14.3

of the GCC and PCC, [Application for IPCs], unless otherwise stipulated. All items will be

paid at 100% completion or on the figures given in the Payment Centre or based on the

part work carried out as decided by the Engineer.

1.4 Centre of Payments (COPs)

The Centre of Payments (Payment Schedule)- refer to Sub-clause 14.3 of the GCC and 83

of PCC Volume 2, for a Payment Centre shows the amount payable to the Contractor for work

carried out in that Payment Centre subject to conditions stated in this Contract and shall be

used to determine the amounts of the interim payments in accordance with Sub-clause 14.3 of

GCC and Subclause 83 of PCC, Volume 2.

As part of the first Monthly Progress Report provided in accordance with Sub-clause 18.5 of

Section A Volume 3, the Contractor shall convert the time scale of the COPs included as part of

the Contractor's Submission from "months after Commencement Date" to months and years

on the Gregorian calendar.

1.5 Payment Concept

Payment will be calculated using the Centre of Payments (COPs), subject to the Engineer being

satisfied that the works are duly completed. Upon mutual agreement between the Engineer and

the Contractor, the individual items of works will be paid proportionately on partial completion. Payment will be based on the Contractor's submission of a monthly statement, in accordance

with Sub-clause 14.3 of GCC and 83 of PCC of Volume 2.

Subject to the Contractor's Monthly Statement meeting the minimum value of 2% of Contract

Price, and after the Employer / the Engineer's assessment, the Employer / the Engineer

will issue an Interim Payment Certificate calculated on percentages from the COP Items.

If any type of work specified in the Centre of Payment is changed, the corresponding Payment

Centres may be changed upon mutual agreement between the Engineer and the Contractor

during design/construction phase.

1.6 Revisions during the contract Period

1.6.1. Revisions to Centre of Payments

The affected Payment Centre total, the Centre of Payments, and the Contractor's Price shall be

adjusted by the Engineer/the Employer with the approval of the Employer to incorporate any

change to the Contract Price. The Contractor shall update the Centre of Payments and submit

to the Engineer for a Notice to proceed.

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1.7 Financial proposal

- 1.7.1.The financial proposal comprises of e-Packet C (Mandatory) and e-Packet C₁ (Optional).
 - (a) The tenderer is required to quote a Lumpsum amount in the Pricing Centre in the e-Packet C.
